<h2>Access to Work</h2>	<p>If you're disabled or have a physical or mental health condition that makes it hard for you to do your job, you can:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> talk to your employer about changes they must make in your workplace get extra help from Access to Work, including mental health support <p>If the help you need at work is not covered by your employer making reasonable adjustments, you may be able to get help from Access to Work. You'll be offered support based on your needs, which may include a grant to help cover the costs of practical support in the workplace.
