## **Housing Options – Information & Advice**

- **Casework** early intervention and the prevention of homelessness, and specialist advice services including:
  - Young people (aged 16-24)
  - People fleeing or experiencing <u>domestic</u> <u>abuse</u>
  - Single homeless and those at risk of rough sleeping
  - People with mortgage difficulties
  - Landlords
  - Assessment and signposting/referrals to specialist providers, such as support

Housing Needs – management of the Housing Register, administration of the 'Homechoice' choice-based letting scheme and the referral of applicants to the partner landlords (Housing Associations/Registered Providers) in accordance with the Council's Allocations Policy.

**Homelessness** – an emergency service covering the assessment and investigation of applications received under the Homelessness legislation.

Temporary Accommodation and Move-on Team — a specialist team dedicated to working with customers who are being assessed as homeless or who are homeless and who are being provided with temporary accommodation. This team manages temporary accommodation, moves on into the private sector or social housing, and works with
